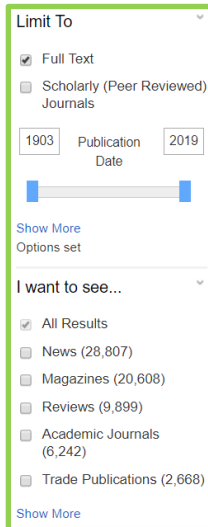

# Go Van Gogh with Discus!

## Discus SmartSearch

SmartSearch retrieves resources from multiple Discus databases and lists them in one result list.



A search for Van Gogh in SmartSearch will provide:

- a *Research Starter* on Van Gogh's life, works, and significance
- articles from magazines, journals, and newspapers
- audios and videos



Refine Results using the left column of the results page to filter results by:

- publication date
- source type (magazine, journal, video, biographies, audio, etc.)
- subject
- Lexile reading level

### Database: *Kids Infobits*

Find elementary school level information on Van Gogh from books, magazines, newspapers, and images.

### Database: *Biography (Gale in Context)*

A Van Gogh search retrieves biographical information, images, audio, and articles from newspapers, magazines, journals, and encyclopedias.

### Database: *Credo Reference*

Access a Van Gogh Topic Page overview, Mind Map, over 200 related images of his work, and reference articles from titles such as:

- *The Bloomsbury Guide to Art*
- *100 Ideas That Changed Art*
- *Handy Art History Answer Book*
- *Thames and Hudson's Dictionary of Art and Artists*
- *Thames and Hudson's Encyclopaedia of Impressionism*
- *Chamber's Encyclopedia of Biography*

### Database: *LEARN360*

Videos cover Van Gogh's early years, Paris, most creative period, mental illness, and legacy

- *Vincent Van Gogh: A Stroke of Genius* (Grades 9-12)
